People around the world celebrate eggs as an excellent, affordable source of high-quality protein and eggs vital role in feeding people around the world.

The U.S. ranks as one of the top countries in egg consumption per capita as estimated by USDA at 263 eggs in 2016. According to the International Egg Commission, Mexico leads the way at 358, followed by Japan at 329.

Iowa is the #1 egg producing state, producing nearly 16 billion eggs per year, which is why we are celebrating World Egg Day at the Park Avenue Hy-Vee, in Des Moines, on October 14th.
